## CURRICULUM MILESTONES

I can choose multiple criteria to **search data** to answer a given question (AND and OR)

I can choose which **attribute** to sort data by to answer a given question

I can choose an appropriate graph to visually compare data

## WHY THIS? WHY NOW? CURRICULUM SEQUENCING AND ASSESSMENT

This unit should be taught after the Year 3 unit on Branching Databases and the Year 4 unit on Data Logging. The unit relates to Maths and Science learning around using data – previous learning across these subjects is therefore also relevant.

The unit prepares children for learning that follows in Year 6 on Spreadsheets but also prepares children for Variables in Year 6 as well.

The unit has an adapted online summative assessment that can be delivered freely through online platform Quizizz.
